OPTION A Runner with 2 Blocks 18' (approx.) OPTION B:

18"x36"

Cushion 1 block 20"x 20"





OPTION C Runner with 3 blocks 18" x 54" (approx.) This class will introduce you to the basic techniques for making a simple bargello block. Once you have a handle on it, the bargello world is your oyster should you want to explore.

# REQUIREMENTS

## FABRIC

The images above are a guideline. The fabric requirements are as follows but bring extra to play with. If you want to enlarge any of the pieces bring fabric to cut as borders.

- 2 x 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips of 9 different fabrics. (18 strips altogether) Use the image above as a guide
- Christmas shades of red, green and white; autumn shades; sea blues,.
- Consider contrast from light to dark as well in your choices
- It could breakdown as follows:
  3 fabrics shades of A; 3 fabrics shades of B, 3 fabrics of lights C.

### BACKING, WADDING, BINDING

Option A Runner	18½" x 42" (approx.)	Wadding and backing 22" x 40"
		Binding 4 strips 2½" wide
Option B Cushion Cover	20" x 20"	Wadding and backing 24" x 24"
		Cushion Back 2 pieces 201/2"x 14"
Option C Runner	18½" x 62" (approx.)	Wadding and Backing 22" x 60"
		Binding 5 strips 2½" wide

### THE USUAL

Sewing machine, ¼" foot, quilting feet. (You never know, we might get that far!!) Rotary cutter, ruler and mat (make sure your blade is sharp) Iron and extension cable. These could be shared between two or three Piecing thread and quilting threads just in case Scissors, pins, ripper

### DON'T BRING any worries or anxiety.

This is meant to be fun and an introduction to the technique. It doesn't have to be perfect. Looking forward to seeing you, Anne Marie
